Computer Based Examinations (CBE)

- CBE can be sat for the first 7 papers of FIA suite of Qualification (FA1, MA1, FA2, MA2, FAB, FMA and FFA) and the first 4 papers of ACCA (F1, F2, and F3, F4).
- 2. CBE can be sat for at any time of the year unlike paper based exams which can only be sat for in March, June, September and December.
- Results for CBE will be immediately available upon the completion of the exams unlike in case of paper based exams for which the result will be released nearly after one & half Month.
