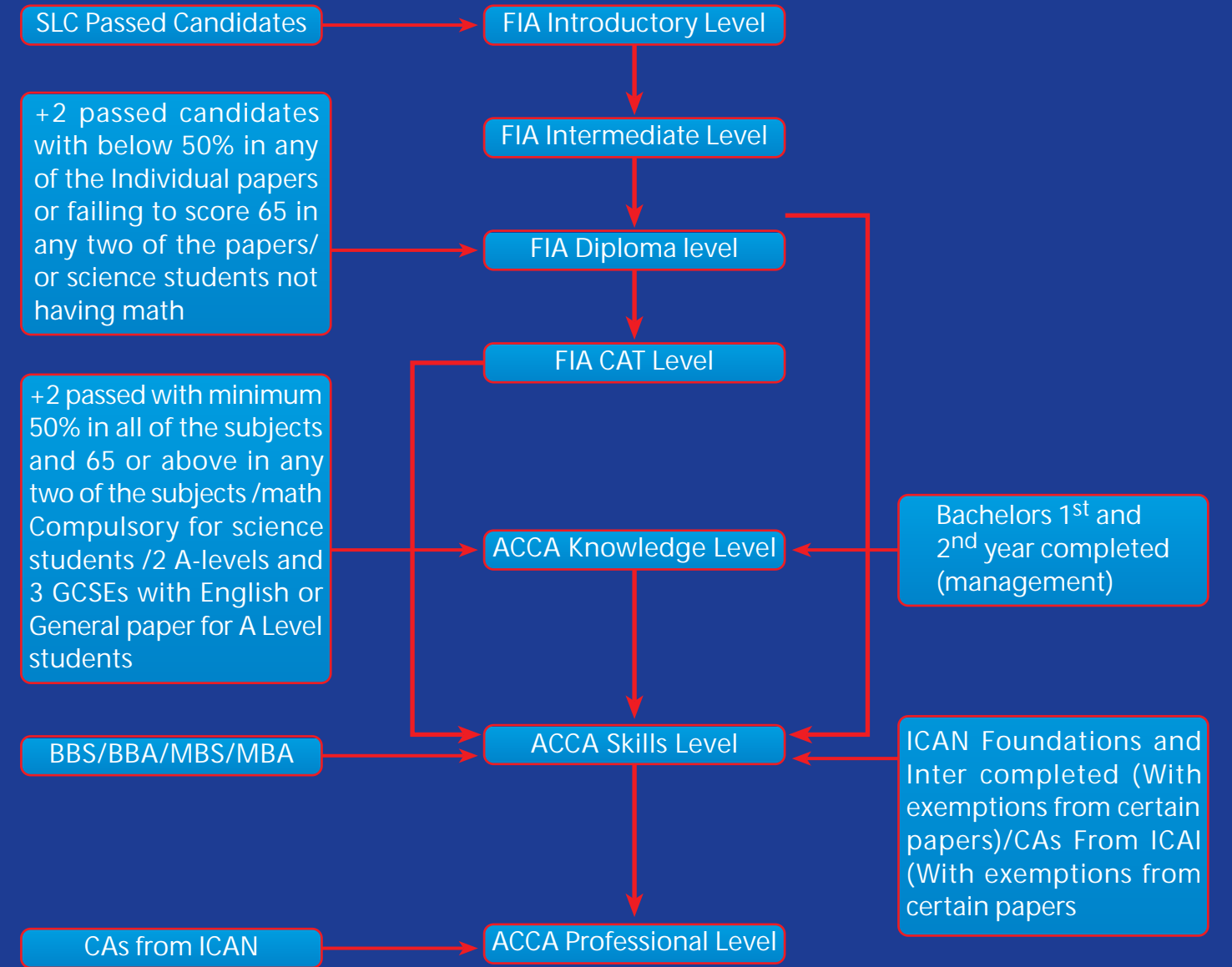

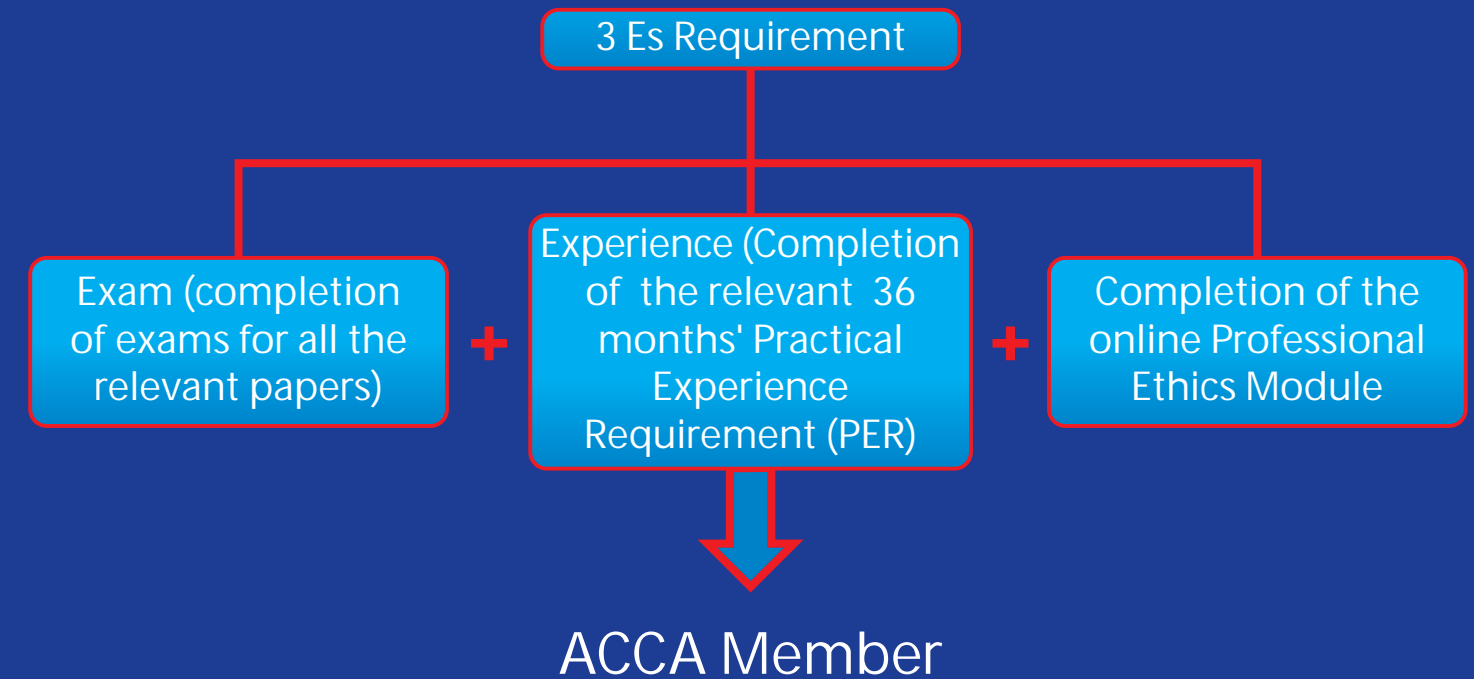

### ACCA Registration

ACCA has an open registration policy meaning that registration can take place throughout the year. Exams are conducted four times a year: March, June, September & December. Therefore, the relevant session in which the student aspires to sit for the exams needs to be borne in mind before undertaking the registration process.

## Computer Based Examinations (CBE)

NCA has been a pioneer in initiating and acquiring the License for the conduction of Computer Based Examinations (CBE). The sole motive behind this is to facilitate the students for the faster progression of their studies.



### Key features of CBE:

1. CBE can be sat for the first 7 papers of FIA suite of Qualification ( FA1, MA1, FA2, MA2, FAB, FMA and FFA ) and the first 4 papers of ACCA (F1, F2, and F3, F4 ).
2. CBE can be sat for at any time of the year unlike paper based exams which can only be sat for in March, June, September and December.
3. Results for CBE will be immediately available upon the completion of the exams unlike in case of paper based exams for which the result will be released nearly after one & half Month.
