
SEARCHING FOR PRACTICAL & TRANSFORMATIVE BACHELOR COURSE?



Bachelor in Development Studies (BDevS) is an internationally recognized and demand driven program offered by National College and affiliated to Kathmandu University. The program focuses on Sustainable Development and Practices. It is an Interdisciplinary study of Economics, Sociology, Environment, Development Management and Research.

This program is based on semester system, which covers four years, spread over eight semesters. Each semester consists of 16 weeks of intensive study- theoretical and practical. The program covers 127 credit hours.



Field Studies

In each semester, students under the supervision of their faculties participate in field studies in various parts of the country. These studies help them understand the ground realities, apply theoretical concepts in practice, and most importantly give them life skill experiences.

Exchange Programs & Int'l Students

The college has established exchangeklicirs with various universities and organizations in Bangladesh, China, Japan, the Philippines and the USA. Each year National College students visit these countries for research, observation and cultural exchange, and the students from those countries visit National College for mutual learning.

National College has been receiving international students, some for full time study and some in a semester abroad program.

Research & Project Work

Research is one of the major strengths of National College. The students are acquainted with knowledge, skills and confidence on field research, and finally become capable to accomplish independent project works in the final semester.

Internship, Job Placement

In collaborations with partner organizations, the college provides students with opportunities of volunteering, internship and jobs. Students of BoSS and BDFin programs also go to Bangladesh, Thailand and the Philippines for their internship placements.

Clubs & Extra Curricular Activities

There are more than 10 specialized students' clubs at National College. These clubs empower the members through extracurricular activities ranging from in-outdoor sports, music, dances, debates, dialogs, literary symposia, paintings, exhibits, flash mobs, social works etc. By the time students graduate, they not just develop life skills but also become familiar with events management.








NATIONAL COLLEGE 1996
