





Background

Why BPH at NOC

NOC is Pokhara University affiliated college. It was established in 2000 AD and it is the first college in Nepal to introduce Health Care Management. It has started BPH program from 2009 of Pokhara University till date. NOC is a well established name in Nepal to study BPH. NOC has also proposed to start MPH program in coming year.

Practical Lab

NOC has well equipped laboratory in Nepal. The practical class is done as per requirement of the course in BPH 1st and 2nd semester so that students can gain practical skill far from theoretical knowledge. Laboratory is big enough for 20 students in one group.

Public Health Faculty

There is one separate public health faculty which includes four full time lectures so students can interact anytime about their difficulties. Students can discuss anytime about their term paper and research paper which is the foundation of research in their career.

Field Visit

Bachelor of Public Health course is designed with many field visits. There are one day visit like Water purification site, Sewage treatment site, Nutritional Rehabilitation Center, Dairy Development center etc according the demand of course. Students have to stay in communities for one month for the course of community diagnosis and one month in different districts for the course of Comprehensive Field Practice. The students of recent batch practiced their Community Diagnosis in villages of Pyuthan district and for Comprehensive Field Practice students were sent to Nuwakot, Rasuwa, Sindhupalanchowk, Dolakha and Makwanpur district.

Teaching Methods

NOC has experienced teachers. NOC has been using modern technology in teaching and learning activities. Teaching is done using LCD, group discussion, audio-visuals etc. A practical and applicable educational teaching model has been used.



Code of Conduct

General

1. Students must attend 90% of classes to be eligible to attend board exam.
2. Leave application must be acknowledged by guardian.
3. Students must enter 5 minutes prior to class hours.
4. Students must be in the college dress code (uniform).
5. Mobile phones are prohibited to use in the class-room and library.
6. Inhuman activities, manners, habits, attitudes and behaviors are strictly subject to disciplinary action. At least one assignment in each subject is a must per week.
7. At least one Assignment in each subject is a must per week.
8. At least one presentation in each subject is a must in a month.
9. Student must appear all internal exams (M1, M2 & M3) to be eligible to attain board exam.
10. Student must secure 70 % marks in each subject in (M1, M2 & M3) exam.
11. Fees are to be paid at the time of the beginning of each semester within 15 days.
12. Internship, field visit, excursion and study visit expenses are not included in the college fee structure.

Account

1. Above fees also include university affiliation, exam, registration and internal evaluation fee.
2. All other fees like practicum, Internship, workshop, educational materials, community diagnosis, council registration are not included in this fee.
3. Students not paying fees at the prescribed time (within 15 days of beginning of semester will be charged 1% fine and will be increased gradually.
4. All fee should be deposit at Bank Account of NOC at Agriculture Development Multipurpose Co- operative Society Lt.d. in front of college building or directly at any branch of Nabil Bank in Account No. 0801013044801.



Library

1. The library/ Identity card must be brought to use the library.
2. All the students, teachers and staff of NOC can be the member of the library.
3. Students have to bear full responsibility for proper care and maintenance of borrowed books.
4. Lost, torn and misused books must be replaced with new books or current market price.
5. Late fine/ due will be charged as per NOC library rules.
6. Late due more than a month will be a cause to cancel the library membership of the user.


