# Objective of Saipal A level

The objective of Saipal A Level is to create an environment that would facilitate extensive learning opportunity and enable each individual to compete at home and abroad.



## Admission Procedure

Prospective students at Saipal A level are required to sit for an entrance examination and interview. Candidates will be offered an admission, based on the admission committee's assessment taking into consideration of past academic performance, performance in the entrance examination, and the level of intelligence.

## Program Details

Cambridge A level courses can comfortably be completed within two years, and there is no time or age limitation for the completion of A level degree.

The courses are divided into two equal halves – first year is called AS (Advanced Subsidiary) and second year is called A2. Students can sit for year wise examination for AS and A2 or directly appear finally for A level which consists of complete two years' curriculum.

## Eligibility for Enrollment

Students who is to pursue A levels at Saipal Academy must have passed SLC or hold and equivalent degrees (O level, CBSE, and so on) to be eligible for admission.

## Enrollment procedure

Admission are announced immediately after the completion of SLC examination each other.

Prospective students are required to collect admission forms and sit for an entrance test. All applicants must submit the following with the application form:

1. Duly completed application form attached with two color passport sized photographs
2. Certified copies of relevant academic/ professional qualification and transcripts
3. Application processing fee Nrs. 1000 /- (gets one Saipal T-shirt)

## EVALAUTION

SAHSS has its own system of internal evaluation for the assessment of the student. They must take terminal tests, involve in classroom presentation and complete every home assignment. Student should mandatorily attend and pass terminal and pre-board examination. The external evaluations are set by the HSEB.

## ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES AND CRITERIA

Admission Eligibility for +2 Programs: Students must have secured at least second division in SLC exams or passed the O levels. Students must visit the college with parents/guardians with equivalent transfer/character certificate, mark sheet, and 2 recent PP size photographs while applying for the admission. Admission arrangements are discussed in detail with parents and it is carried out on the basis of entrance test followed by an interview. Students must pass SAHSS entrance test to be qualified for the admission. The final selection is decided by the selection committee of the college. Students must fill in a commitment form at the time of admission. Enrollment fee is only charged once for the entire session.

## FUTURE PROGRAMS

The college has a plan to launch BBA program to cater the need of business organisation. It also envisions to start Masters Level programs in the future.

## SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES

SAHSS has a provision of scholarship in different categories:

- ▶ Scholarship for Martyrs' Children, riot hit or handicapped parent's children- 2 Quota
- ▶ Scholarship for backward class, poor family, and meritorious students-8 Quota
- ▶ 75%-79% SLC Result: 20% Scholarship in monthly fee. If student couldn't maintain the same position in mock/term exams, the scholarship will be nullified.
- ▶ 80%-85% SLC result: 45% scholarship in monthly fee. If student couldn't maintain the same position in mock/term exams, the scholarship will be nullified.
- ▶ 86 % and above SLC result: 100% Scholarship in monthly tuition fee. The student must maintain the same position in mock/term exams for the continuation of the scholarship.

### NOTE:

- ▶ Practical fee and annual fee will be charged from these students.
- ▶ To empower the students, special scholarship quotas are reserved for the following categories: students from very remote area-2 Quota; students from Dalit Community- 2 Quota; economically unprivileged students-2 Quota; students referred by HSEB-2 Quota.


