Enrollment Procedure

The eligible students have to fill up the admission form and sit for the entrance test. As they get through the test, they, along with their parents, have to sit for an interview. Then, they have to enroll themselves within 3 days submitting the following documents:

- A copy of Character/ Transfer Certificate
- A copy of SEE Grade Sheet
- Two pp size photos

NB: The management will not accept the students' admission after all the seats are occupied even though they have met the eligibility criteria.

Scholarship Scheme
