

 (which will be during the 1st year)

e.g: Physics (A or AS) means Physics is offered in both the first year (AS) and second year.
 Computer Science (AS) means Computer Science is offered only in first year.

CIE Board Examination:
 AS in May / June , A2 in May / June

There might be a possibility for science students to take one non-science subject and vice versa depending on the schedule.

SCIENCE SUBJECTS COMBINATION

Students interested in taking science track will have to take the mandatory subjects and choose one group out of the 3 groups shown.

Science Group 1 Subject Choices

Physics (A or AS),
 Biology (A or AS),
 Chemistry(A or AS),
 Computer Science (AS) OR Sociology (A or AS)

From each of the groups the student will need to choose at least 2 A level subject (A) and 1 AS level subject (AS).

Physics (A or AS),
 Biology (A or AS),
 Chemistry(A or AS),
 Computer Science (AS) OR Sociology (A or AS)

Mandatory Subjects For All Science Groups
 General Paper (AS),
 Mathematics(A)

Science Group 3 Subject Choices

Physics (A or AS),
 Chemistry(A or AS),
 Computer Science (AS)

Mandatory Subjects For Non Science Group
 General Paper (AS), Mathematics(AS)

NON SCIENCE SUBJECTS COMBINATION

Students interested in taking non-science track will have to take at least 3 A Level subjects and 1 AS Level subject by the end of the program. This will include the mandatory subjects.

If the students takes Maths as A Level then he/she will have to choose at least 2 A Level subjects for the subject choices. If he/she takes only AS Maths then he/she will have to take 3 A Level subject from the subject choices.





DRESS CODE

Students have to wear formal attire consisting of black pants and off-white shirt with black shoes (sweater during the winter) once a week, on Fridays while students can wear clothes of their choice for the rest of the week (their clothes need to be in accordance with the dress code specified by the college). We believe this will allow the students the space to express themselves responsibly.

SUBJECT RECOMMENDATION

The students who want to pursue Medical Studies or any other science courses in the future are recommended to choose Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology and General Paper. The students who would like to pursue Management Courses in the future are recommended to choose Accounts, Business Studies, Economics, Mathematics and General Paper.

* SXC does not have hostel facility or bus services.

ELIGIBILITY

- * Student must have completed SLC or any other equivalent degree such as but not limited to:
 - GCE O level (General Certificate of Education – Ordinary Level),
 - CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education)
 - IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education),
 - ICSE (Indian Certificate of Secondary Education)
- * Have a minimum average score of 70 %
- * Students opting for science course must have taken optional mathematics in classes 9 & 10 and those opting for non-science subject must have taken either economics or accounts.
- * Must have excellent command of English.
- * Must be highly committed to the program and prepared to work tremendously hard during the program
- * Must be able to work in group and be very punctual (meet deadlines)
- * Must be confident, curious and active learner.

* Students must produce photocopy of passport or citizenship card within six months of admission.
