Notice for online form submission (FOREIGN APPLICANTS) of Entrance Examination for admission in Bachelor Level Programmes in Constituent Campuses & Affiliated Colleges of the Institute of Medicine, Tribhuvan University, Nepal

It is hereby notified that eligible candidates (Non-Nepalese) may apply online for admission into various Bachelor Level programmes for the academic session 2019 of the Institute of Medicine. The details about the application process, the entrance test, relevant dates and deadlines are as follows:

**Note: It is mandatory for all foreign candidates to appear and pass the entrance test conducted by the Institute of Medicine to apply for admission in any programme in constituent campuses & affiliated colleges of the Institute of Medicine, Tribhuvan University.**

**2. Information about online application form submission:**

- The Application form is available at [www.iomexam.edu.np](http://www.iomexam.edu.np) and [www.iom.edu.np](http://www.iom.edu.np). *It must be completed and submitted online.*
- The candidate must fill separate application forms for separate programmes.
- Bank voucher is not required at the time of submission of the application form.
- After submission of the form, the candidate should print the *Confirmation Sheet* that is generated.
- The candidate / applicant is then required to deposit the application fee in the bank and obtain a deposit voucher.
- The Admit Card for the entrance test can be collected between 10:00 AM, 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2019 and 4:00 PM, 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 from the *Department of Information Technology*, Institute of Medicine, Maharajgunj.
- To obtain the Admit Card, the candidate **must** be present in person with the following documents:

*Passport / Aadhar Card, Confirmation Sheet and the Bank voucher.*

#### 4. Documents / Identification at the time of Entrance Examination:

At the time of the entrance examination, each applicant is required to carry the admit card (obtained from the IT Department of the Institute of Medicine).

The identity of the applicants shall be verified before the entrance test using biometric data obtained from the candidate at the time of issue of Admit Card.

#### 5. Entrance Examination:

Each candidate can apply for a maximum of three programmes, viz. **MBBS**, **BDS** and **ANY ONE** of the following allied health sciences programmes: B.Optometry, B.Pharmacy, B.Sc. MIT, B.Sc.MLT or BAMS.

Separate online application forms need to be submitted for each desired programme. Also, candidates must pay application fees separately for each submitted application.

For the test, there will be a single set of 100 multiple choice questions (MCQs) each worth 1 mark for a total of 100 full marks. Each question will have four possible options, with a single correct response. A single answer sheet will be provided to the candidate to mark the answers. The answer sheet consists of 4 bubbles as shown below:

Which one of the following insects transmits Kala-azar?



All candidates should use the **Black Gel Ink Pen** (provided at the examination centre) to mark their answers. They should **fill the correct bubble** in the answer sheet using the black gel pen.

All instances where a single bubble is not filled, including **more than one bubble marked**, use of correcting fluids, pencil marks and use of other signs like "X", "✓" in the bubble **SHALL NOT BE SCORED**.



There will be No Negative Marking.

The answer sheet will be invalid if the *name* and *roll number* fields are not filled up.

After fifteen minutes of commencement of the examination, no candidate shall be allowed entry into the examination hall. Also, candidates will not be allowed to leave the examinations hall before the exam time is over.

All candidates are **Strictly Prohibited** from carrying mobile phones, Bluetooth devices, Tablet PCs, Smart Watches, Wireless Earphones or other electronic gadgets and in addition, wallets, purses, ornaments / jewellery or any form of stationery including pens / pencils. **Any candidate found in possession of any of these items shall be IMMEDIATELY EXPELLED from the examination.**

For candidates that need glasses, it is to be noted that only prescription glasses are allowed in the examination hall, which shall be subjected to inspection prior to commencement of the examination.

It is also to be noted that it is upon the jurisdiction of the examinations division to inspect any suspicious candidate at any time before, during and after the examination.

#### 6. Result publication & Admission Process:

- a) The results of the entrance exam will be published online.
- b) A candidate has to score at least 50% of the total marks to pass the examination.
- c) The date for online counseling/open house counseling will be fixed later and published on the web page.
- d) Admissions to both constituent campuses and affiliated colleges will be done strictly on the basis of merit and the result will be published online.
- e) Any successful candidate that appeared in the tests for MBBS and BDS programme can choose other allied health sciences programme on the basis of merit if seats are left vacant through open house counseling. Similarly, successful candidates applying to other programmes can choose any of the allied health science programmes **EXCEPT** MBBS/BDS.

#### DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION:

- *School Leaving Certificate or equivalent/10+2 educational qualification certificate, mark-sheets /transcript, Character certificate*
- *Valid Passport or Aadhar Card*
- *Migration Certificate*
- *Certificate of Equivalence*
- *Certificate of Health* (Hearing, Vision including color vision and Hepatitis B vaccination)

- f) In the event that any falsified information has been provided during the entrance examination or admission process, the admission will be cancelled and void as soon as it comes to the notice of the Institute of Medicine, even after commencement of the academic calendar.
- g) All students must abide by the rules and regulations of the Institute of Medicine, Tribhuvan University.
- h) Classes commence on 18<sup>th</sup> of October, 2019. If a student is absent without prior information for more than 15 days after classes begin, the admission will be automatically cancelled. The next student(s) in the merit list can apply for admission for this vacant seat within 35 days of commencement of the academic session. Any seats remaining vacant after 35 days can be fulfilled by students from the merit list within 90 days of commencement of the academic session in the condition that his/her academic session will be delayed by six months, which includes assessments and examinations.
- i) The students that are enrolled in the MBBS/BDS programme **MUST** pass all the subjects taught in the **1<sup>st</sup> Phase** (**1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Year for MBBS/BDS**) & **1<sup>st</sup> Professional** for BAMS before they move on to the **2<sup>nd</sup> phase/2<sup>nd</sup> Professional** programme. A candidate can have a **Maximum of four attempts** to pass his **1<sup>st</sup> Phase** papers. Any student failing to clear all Phase 1 papers / subjects after four attempts will be removed from the undergraduate programme. A student can, however, **defer the university exams for a maximum of two times**, without filling the exam forms, for which his / her examination attempts shall not be counted.
- j) Upon admission, the selected student cannot appear in entrance examinations of the Institute of Medicine for any other programme until the completion of the designated course.
