SIMULATOR 0 by ForumIAS is scheduled to be conducted on 11/04/2021, Sunday.

To ensure a smooth conduct of the test considering the number of students that have registered, we have designed time **slots** in which you can give the test. You will be given a particular time slot which will be informed to you via an email.

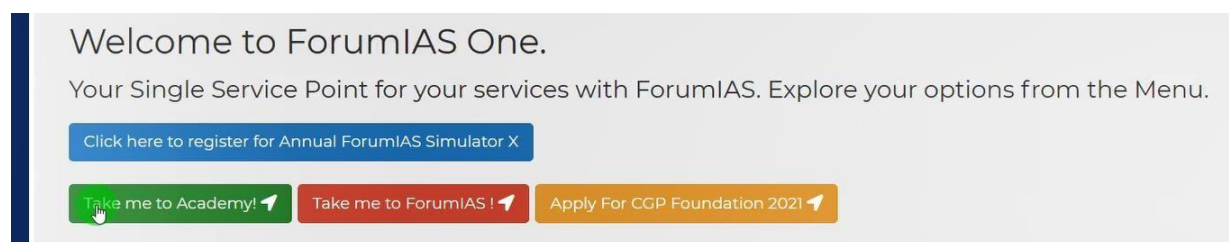
If you are unable to write the Test at the designated time slot, you can write it any time after 2:30 PM (April 11).

Please note:

1. You will be able to start the test only if you have registered for simulator 0.
2. Solutions and video discussion will be uploaded by 9 PM on 11th April.

Please go through the instructions given below on how to write ForumIAS's Simulator 0 for Prelims 2021.

Step # 1: Log on to the portal at **one.forumias.com** (ensure to login atleast 5 minutes prior to test start time) and after log in click on the green button titled **“Take me to the academy”** refer the image below.



Step # 2: Click on “**Click here for Open Test**”. Refer the image below.

Your designated test slot is 09:30 AM-11:30 AM(11th April). In case you missed this slot you can attempt it after 2.30PM (April 11)

Click here for Open Test

Continue to Academy

Note: this button will work only if it's your time slot as we have designated time slots according to your ForumIAS ID.

If your designated time slot is not the on-going slot, then the message “**click here for open test**” will not work.

Step # 3 : If it's your time slot then after you click on the button “**click here for open test**” a new window will open, and it will show only one test which will be your Open test.

Click on “**Start Test**”.
