Plan - From Basics to Pro

- **Level 1:** The 22 Tests in this level ensure you have read through at least one recommended standard book for the subject and upgraded your knowledge. For handholding, the detailed topics and the chapter number for the tests have been provided. This level will be divided into two sections: the Half Length tests and the full tests.

Half Length Tests: The idea for Half Length tests, is to deep dive into syllabus and to cover all hidden syllabus of the specified topics. This feature will also encourage you to prepare and revise in a planned and routine manner with smaller achievable targets. Each of these tests will have 50 questions which you will have to attempt in one hour. This pattern will also test your speed and agility of mind, preparing you to handle stressful environment of the Prelims. The Half Length tests will be followed by full tests.

Full Tests: The objective of the full tests is twofold, first, to revise the syllabus already covered in the Half Length tests and second to provide a 360-degree coverage of all aspects of the specified subject.

- **Level 2:** The 5 Tests in this level will ensure that you have a timely and a comprehensive second revision of all subjects. The questions would be a bit on the tougher side. It will help in developing the problem-solving skill and further develop your aptitude. No special reading is required at this level, a thorough revision of sources studied during level 1, will suffice.
- **Level 3:** The SIMULATOR™: The 8 GS Simulator Tests along with 8 CSAT Simulator Tests will make sure that you have undergone different quality/difficulty and pattern for the Prelims paper by simulating the past 5 - 6 years of UPSC papers. In effect, you will be writing the prelims 8 times before the one the final prelims exam.

The simulators help to make the Prelims exam predictable for you. They provide for timely assessment gauging the competition. While Knowledge Base can be developed by reading standard books, the other aspect - problem-solving skills, elimination skills and decision making comes with practising previous years' papers and solving high-quality Simulator test papers.

Horizontal Support through different levels:

- Current Affairs to be holistically covered from June 2021 to April 2022. In each test we will be covering the current affairs for 10 days, mentioned in the timetable.
- Each Full Test will have 15 - 20 questions on current affairs.
