


Curriculum



**Approximate order of retreats** 

#### A - Preliminaries


All modules are mandatory; the precise order and other details depend on the student.



- A1 The Four Common Preliminaries
  - Each module will take three, five, or seven days.
- A2 The Mahamudra Preliminaries
  - All four modules together will take about six months.
  - The distribution of time between modules depends on students' conditions.

#### B - Mind Training


All modules are mandatory; the precise order and other details depend on the student.



- B1 Lojong
  - This module will take about one month.
- B2 Shamatha & Vipashyana
  - This module will take about one month.

### C - Generation Stage


Between one for all three categories and one in each category, depending on the student.



- C1 Guru Yoga
  - This module takes about 3 weeks.
- C2 Yidam Practice
  - This module takes about 6 months.
- C3 Protector Practice
  - This module takes about 3 months.
- Using only one or two practices across all three categories is possible and choosing to do so depends on the student. However, it doesn't necessarily cut down retreat time.

#### A/B/C - Possible Overlap


By default, the practices are completed in order, however, depending on the student, some overlaps are possible.



- A2.4/C1 Guru Yoga
  - These two can be joined by choosing only one guru yoga and using it already during the preliminaries.
- B2/C Shamatha & Vipashyana
  - Shamatha and Vipashyana can be practiced as part of any or all of the generation stage practices.
- These overlaps depend on the student. Choosing to do so, however, will not necessarily cut down on retreat time

## D - Completion Stage


At least one of the six yogas, depending on the student.



• Expect this stage to take six months or more.

#### E - Accomplishment


It is not feasible to predict the duration for this module.




