

We work with schools to provide engaging, interactive health education for children in your community. We are a not-forprofit charity and are not funded by the Government.

The Life Education programme covers a wide range of health topics under five major themes: food and nutrition; body systems; self esteem; social relationships; and substances.

The sessions delivered are flexible to the needs of the individual schools. All lessons are delivered in our purpose built mobile classrooms offering a unique, high tech and modern learning environment for children.

New Zealand has one of the highest child obesity rates in the OECD, and we know this leads to poor mental health, higher incidences of being a victim of bullying and lower educational achievement. (Unicef Innocenti Report Card 2020)
