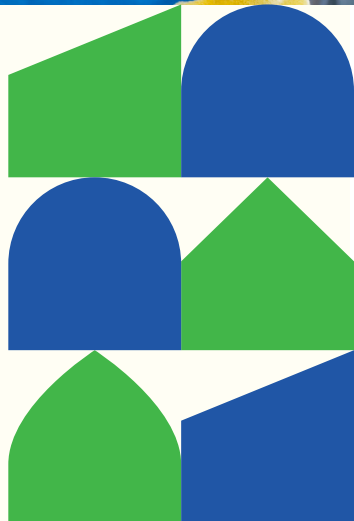

Like all 31 local Life Education Trust branches, they receive no government funding and rely on grants, student contributions, and local fundraising to sustain their programmes.

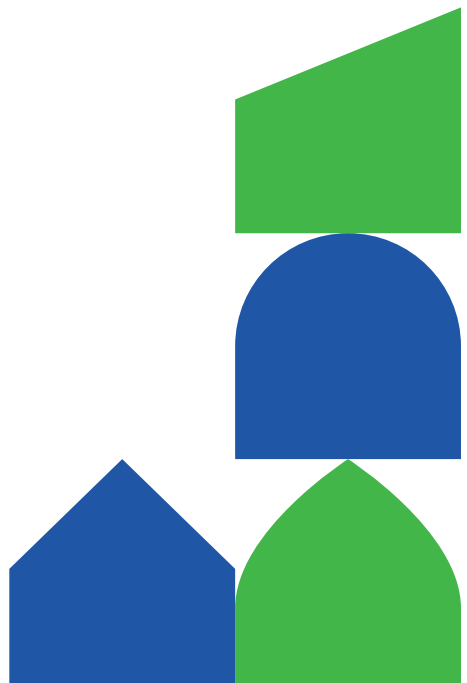
At Tommy's, we value the Life Education programme as a crucial community asset. That's why we're committed to continuing the delivery of the Healthy Harold programme in schools.
