**Annual report on Post Graduate Diploma and Guidance Course (PGDGC)**  
**(2024-25)**

Post Graduate Diploma Guidance and Counseling (PGDGC) is a self-financed course started in the year 2021-2023 at MBGPG College, Haldwani. 20 students were enrolled out of 30 seats available in the first batch i.e., 2021-23. All the students were passed with flying colours. Bhawana Jalal secured first rank with 78% followed by Pratibha Pandey with 77.8% and Ekta Pauriyal with 77.2%. All these students are now giving back to the society by working at rehabilitation centres, schools and various institutions. Due to some unforeseen circumstances, the first batch was delayed. After this, each batch is continuing according to the one-year program schedule.

In 2022-23 batch, 17 students were enrolled all of them are desperately waiting for their final results. In 1st semester Saurabh secured first rank with 80.8%, Followed by Samriddhi Pathak with 80% and Rahul with 78.6%. Impressively, many students have already begun working as counsellors, demonstrating their commitment to the field and will contribute for well-being of the society in future. In 2023-24, 8 students have enrolled for this course. During 2nd semester of PGDGC, all students have to go for an internship course at any state government hospital for 3 months. In the year 2024-25, 12 students have enrolled themselves or the course. The current batch has undertaken the mandatory, 3 months internship programme in Sushila Tewari Medical Hospital, Haldwani.

This report highlights the program's achievements since its inception.

1. The PGDGC program has seen a successful launch with consistent enrolment and a 100% pass rate in the first graduating batch.
2. The curriculum equips them with the knowledge and skills to excel in guidance and counseling roles.
3. Graduates are actively contributing to society by working in various institutions.
4. Students consistently demonstrate academic excellence, with toppers achieving high marks.
5. The internship program provides invaluable practical experience, preparing them to effectively serve society.
6. The program empowers graduates to make a significant contribution to the well-being of individuals and communities.
