S. No.	Event participation	Description
1.	Regional level workshop on WOSM and WAGGGS, 1 <sup>st</sup> – 5 <sup>th</sup> Sept. 2024, Leela Beri Training Centre, Raiwala, Dehradun	Altogether 5 Rovers and 4 Rangers participated in the camp, where the total strength was 150 students. Apart from WOSM and WAGGGS, a talk on United Nations 17 Sustainable Development Goals was delivered for the benefit of the students
2.	Trekking from Ranibagh, Haldwani to Naukuchiyatal, 16 <sup>th</sup> Sept 2024	The annual trekking event, led by Rivers & Rangers in-charge, Dr, Govind Bora, included 24 Rovers and 24 Rangers.
