1.	Regional level workshop on WOSM and WAGGGS, 1 st – 5 th Sept. 2024, Leela Beri Training Centre, Raiwala, Dehradun	Altogether 5 Rovers and 4 Rangers participated in the camp, where the total strength was 150 students. Apart from WOSM and WAGGGS, a talk on United Nations 17 Sustainable Development Goals was delivered for the benefit of the students
