Career Counseling Workshop — "Job Opportunity as Assistant Manager in Axis Bank through NIIT", 8<sup>th</sup> March 2025. Sc, Botany, in Axis Bank), Kum Kanchan Singh (M.A., English, in HDFC Bank), after due process of qualifying the Ability aptitude test, followed by interview through online-mode, and finally interview in front of the Bank officials/experts.

The primary objective of this workshop was to provide students with career guidance regarding job opportunities as Assistant Manager in Axis Bank through NIIT. The session aimed to familiarize students with the recruitment process, required qualifications, and training programs that can lead to career opportunities in the banking sector.
