## PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION MEETING REPORT (2024-25)

The Parent Teacher Association of M.B.P.G. College, Haldwani is a vital body functioning as a bridge between— the institution and parents aiming to promote a collaborative environment for the holistic development of the students. The College organized two different PTA meetings in the academic session 2024-25 with a purpose of strengthening the Parent-Teacher communication and working together for the all-inclusive growth of the students. The first meeting was held on 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 followed by the second meeting on 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2025.

The programme commenced with an inaugural address by the Principal and Patron, Prof. N.S. Bankoti. He welcomed all the guardians with emphasizing on the Community Involvement concept which plays a pivotal role in the well-rounded development of the student. His address was followed by that of the Secretary, PTA, Dr. Urvashi Pandey who welcomed all the Heads of Departments, Conveners of all committees and guardians. Professor B.R. Pant, HOD, Department of Geography, elaborated on the concept of PTA and laid emphasis on the significance of the Feed Back by the parents, as an integral part of parent-teacher collaboration. The event was followed by the unique interactive session by the IQAC coordinator, Professor C.S. Negi, where he accentuated on the importance of involvement of students in the overall activities of the college from which emanate their achievements. He presented a detailed review of the academic environment and student engagement in different college activities. Dr. Urvashi Pandey presented a brief account of the functioning of the various committees, their relevance and purposes in the first and provided an overview of the association's ongoing activities. Her address included updates on the progress made since the first meeting.

A Power point presentation further foregrounded the different facets of the college education which included a detailed capturing of the infrastructural updates, the academic and co-curricular progress of the students, the on and off campus achievements of the students, the various bodies designed and functioning for student welfare and catering to their grievances. Both occasions served as a collaborative platform for discussing academic progress, student welfare, grievances, opportunities and challenges, infrastructural concerns with respect to the students of the college.

### The overview of the first meeting are as follows:

**Discussion on Academics and Active Committees-** The IQAC coordinator and the Secretary of PTA provided a comprehensive synopsis of the academic environment of the college along with the various committees functional at present.

**Question and Feedback (Interactive session with the parents)-** The interactive segment provided parents a platform to express their concerns and suggestions. Key issues raised included:

- The problem of fewer washrooms
- The cleanliness and hygiene in washrooms
- Dress code for the students
- Regularity of students.
- Discipline
- Books

#### **Faculty Response to Parental Concerns**

- Dr. Kavita Bisht, Proctor, responded to concerns regarding student discipline and attendance, urging parents to monitor and support their children's academic involvement.
- Prof. C.S. Negi addressed library concerns. He assured that new books would be added and proposed a better circulation system for textbooks. Parents agreed to support timely book returns.
- Regarding infrastructure, Principal Prof. N.S. Bankoti confirmed that a proposal for constructing additional washrooms had already been initiated and was under review.

#### **Felicitation Ceremony:**

Two students from the NSS unit were felicitated for their notable achievements in social service and leadership roles.

### **Second PTA Meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2025**

The second meeting of the Parent Teacher Association (PTA) for the academic session 2024–25 was held on 5th May, 2025 in the Conference Hall of M.B.P.G. College, Haldwani. The meeting again witnessed enthusiastic participation from parents, faculty members, and college administrators. It served as a collective platform for re-discussing the student centric issues for their comprehensive growth. The meeting focused on the review and resolution of concerns raised by parents during the second meeting held in May 2025. It also aimed at strengthening collaboration for continued academic and infrastructural improvements.

### **The Overview of the Second Meeting**

#### **A Brief Synopsis of the Previous Meeting**

- The event commenced with the presentation of the brief synopsis of the previous meeting.
- The concerns raised earlier were reviewed for the assessment of the actions taken by the institution and the parents.
- The suggestions provided earlier were also highlighted.

#### **A Follow-up Report by the Secretary**

Dr. Urvashi Pandey, Secretary of the PTA, presented a follow-up report on the action taken regarding previously raised issues. She provided updates on each concern, highlighting the timely response and improvements made by the institution. A Power Point Presentation, including all the progress the college made, in the months between the first meeting where the issues were raised till date was run simultaneously.

### **Addressing the Concerns of the Parents Raised in the Previous Meeting.**

- Issue about girl's washroom was duly initiated for a resolution by improving the availability and hygiene issues.
- Dress code had been implemented in several courses and efforts were being made to implement it in all courses in future.
- Books were a major challenge in the multitude of students studying in the college. Following initiatives were taken
  - Free Subscription to online libraries was to be provided to the students.

- The facility of E-Granthaalaya, another e-library resource could be availed by the students.
  - Book rotation was to be made mandatory for all students.
  - A practice of book pooling could be encouraged.
- The parents were told about the various scholarships; the students could avail.
  - The parents were urged to encourage the habit of daily presence of their wards in classes to meet out the challenge of irregularity which would in turn reflect on their academic growth as well.

### **Interactive Session.**

**Issues Raised by Parents-** The two major issues raised by the parents were as follows:

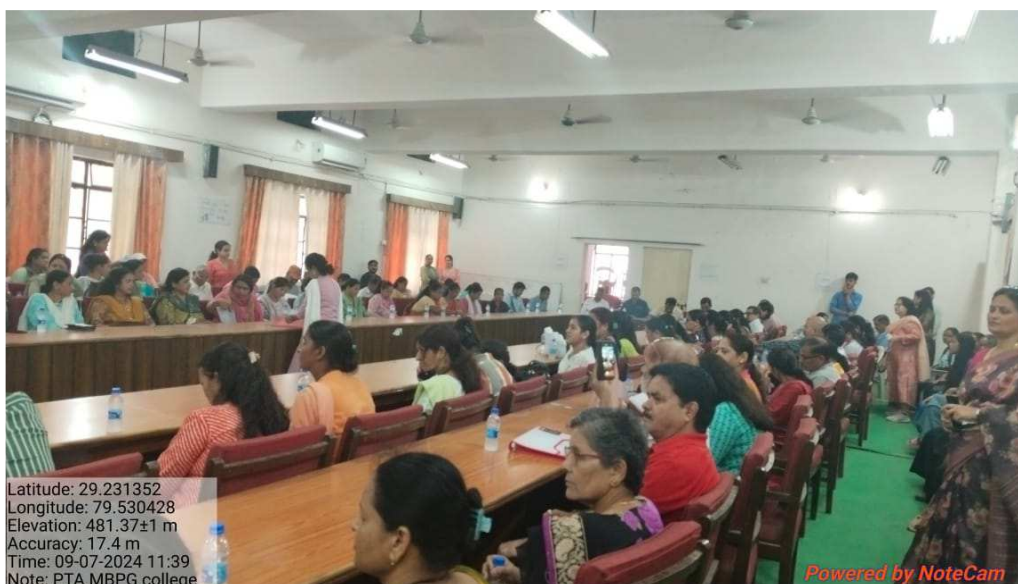
- About the delayed result.
- About the problem of shortage of books (which remained to be a concern)

### **Addressing the Parents' concern**

- The Principal, Prof. N.S. Bankoti, addressed the issue, assuring the parents about the constructive role of the examination committee in facilitating the exam and evaluation process.
- Prof B. R. Pant, In-Charge, Examination Committee, also clarified the role of university in the entire process.
- Prof. C.S. Negi enlightened the parents about utilizing the Reading Room of the college as a valuable resource, crafted specially for the purpose of providing the students with a dedicated space for knowledge enhancement. His reemphasised on the concept of online library subscription, as a remedy.

**General address By Dr. N.S. Sijwali-** Dr. N.S. Sijwali emphasised on the importance of parents' communication with their children. He requested the parents to establish a genuine dialogue with their children for their overall growth.

**Feedback by Parents-** The parents were satisfied with most of the solutions given by the College. They assured of being instrumental in working upon the attendance of their wards. They expressed their satisfaction with the academics as well as the on and off campus activities related to student upliftment.
