6.1.1 - The governance of the institution is reflective of and in tune with the vision and mission of the institution

An institution's governance is considered effective when its structure, policies, and decision-making bodies are aligned with its vision and mission. This alignment is demonstrated through participative management, the establishment of relevant committees (such as IQAC, R&D, and placement cells), clear implementation of the perspective plans, and effective communication of institutional goals to staff and students, as well as other stakeholders. The effective governance is carried out through the following vital cogs, which runs the overall institutional ecosystem:

Institutional head- He/She is responsible for the overall smooth running of the institution, and achievement of the goals set forth in the institutional vision plan and mission. In his/her efforts, he/she is aided by select statutory committees, each mandated with specific tasks, such as admission, examination, student union elections, IQAC, Students grievances redressal, and so forth, as also the administrative and working staff.

Participative Management- It is obligatory on the part of the institution to address the issues not just of the enrolled students, and the staff, and redress them, but more important, such efforts need to be timely, efficient, and effective. Hence, the need for the Alumni, Parent Teacher Meets (PTA), which remain an effective mechanism to 'Get-to-know' the problems faced by their wards, and thus redress them.

Committee Structure- Various statutory committees are thus committed to addressing the above issues, as well as aid in the overall governance. Such committees are mandated with the respective tasks for a minimum period of 3 years, i.e., the committees are re-constituted, as per the needs; as also, as per the recommendation of the University Grants Commission, New Delhi, from time to time. In this regard, it's important to highlight a few committees, which play a pivotal role in the implementation of the policies, guidelines (say, those stipulated by NAAC, UGC, as also Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Uttarakhand). These are IQAC, Career Counselling Cell, Research & Development Cell, Students Grievances Redressal Cell, which align with the set goals and the institutional vision. Towards achievement of the set goals, it is important that such committees evolve an annual plan of activities, and stick to it.

Accountability, decision making, and Transparency- The principal tasks of the institution remain admission strictly carried out within the stipulated time span, classes being run smoothly, and syllabi covered well before the time, so that additional revision or remedial classes could be taken; and conduction of flawless examination. Institutionalising a

transparent mechanism of holding student union elections, and creation of a pro-student environment in the college. Towards these ends, the principal calls upon the Heads of the departments meet, and thereby makes decision on academic frameworks, major reforms, if required, as also devising the long-term strategies, which would not just reflect but more importantly strengthen the institutional image.

IQAC Cell- IQAC is responsible for setting goals, as per the vision plan of the institute, as also as per the salient goals based on the 7 criteria stipulated by NAAC. In fact, IQAC is responsible for implementing and translating the policies into concrete actions, as also, gathering feedback (principally Student feedback & satisfaction report), and ensure continuous improvement.

Upkeep & maintenance of the Finances, and audit reports- It is vital to make sure that a transparent mechanism is implemented in the utilization of the finances, towards supporting the activities and infrastructural needs of the institute, and towards achieving the institution's vision and mission. Regular internal as well as external auditing, thus remains an obligatory part of checks & balances, as relates to utilization of the funds available.

The overall governance is thus geared towards achieving the set goals as sated in the vision statement, and reflects upon the prime goals stipulated by NAAC. To list some of the major initiatives or tasks carried out in the year, mention may be made of few:

(1) Green campus initiatives- (i) Plantation work undertaken, (ii) vermicompost pit made functional, (iii) local municipal body mandated for regular disposal of the waste, (iv) operationalisation of the 6 KW installed Solar panels,

2. *Academic-* (i) Establishment of book banks, (ii) ICT-based classrooms strengthened, (iii) Procurement of books as per the requirements of the New Education Policy, and (iv) Subscription of journals and competitive magazines; subscription to DelNet and registration of ONOS.

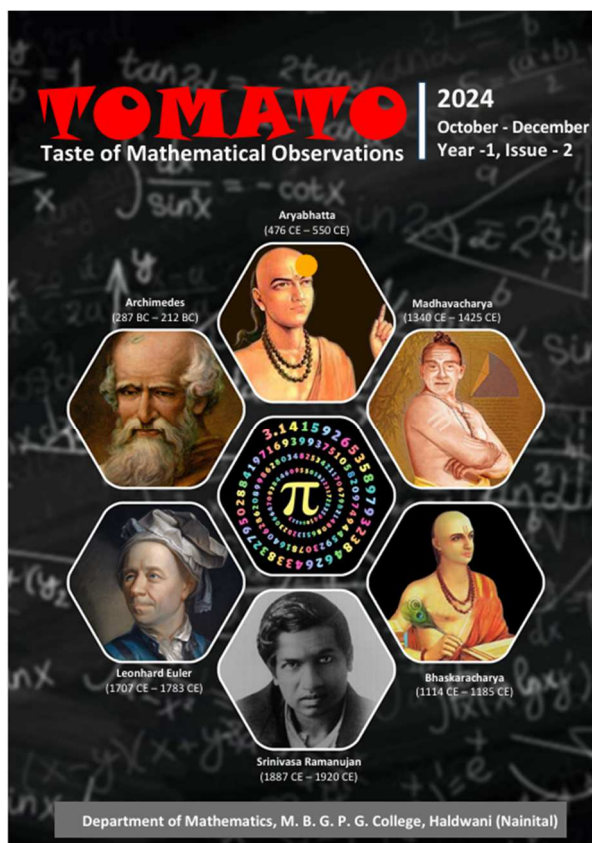
3. *Conduction of workshops and seminars, including international conferences-* Seminars and workshops were conducted across different departments, and invited or expert talks organised. Workshops (02) on IPR and Patents were held.

4. *PTA and Alumni meets-* were held on a regular basis

5. *Celebration of commemorative days-* National, as well as international commemorative days, were celebrated, with expert talks and competitions held.

6. *Entrepreneurship Development Programmes-* were organised, workshops and exhibition held. A number of faculty members attended entrepreneurship development workshop in EDII, Ahmedabad.

7. One online as well as print Journal- TOMATO is periodically printed and distributed. The students are encouraged to contribute their articles; as also few have been included in the editorial board of the magazine.
