7.1.9 - Sensitization of students and employees of the Institution to the constitutional obligations: values, rights, duties, and responsibilities of citizens

1. Many of the subjects offered have topics that sensitize the students about constitutional obligations. The major subjects that deal with the constitutional provisions are the following-
B. Ed, Education, and Political Science.
2. As per the Supreme Court directive, constitutional provisions relating to wildlife protection, and the environment, in general, are taught to the 4th semester students (earlier 2nd year students), across different streams- Science, Arts, and Commerce, in the college, as also mandatory- Environmental and value education, under the mandated Value-added course, as per NEP 2.0.
3. Regular workshops on raising awareness about the Rights of the girl child, Sexual Harassment, gender equality, and ragging-related issues, are organized. The NSS students and faculty in charge are actively involved in such causes.
4. The Eco-club constituted in the college carries out awareness campaigns on International Days, such as Earth Day, and Environment Day when issues such as Swachh Bharat, etc are conducted.
5. Similarly, the Department of Psychology, Sexual Harassment (Prevention, Prohibition, and Redressal) Cell regularly organizes women's rights, and sexual harassment (laws related, etc), etc on a regular feature where efforts are made to invite experts on these socially relevant issues to render talks to the girl students. In addition, the Mental Health & Wellness Centre imparts counseling services and expertise.
6. The Code of conduct for students, teaching faculty, the working staff as also for the administrative head, is posted in the college website.
7. During the initial orientation programme organised for the new entrants to the college/department, the students are sensitized towards their duties, their rights, and responsibilities, both as a citizen, and more importantly, as a student, towards creating a better academic environment in the college, and its smooth functioning.
8. Prior to the Annual Students Union Elections, the interest candidates fighting the elections, too are given a detail talk on the different provisions of the Lyngdoh committee recommendations, as also about the constitutional provisions/obligation, which need to be adhered to, throughout the conduction and culmination of the elections.
