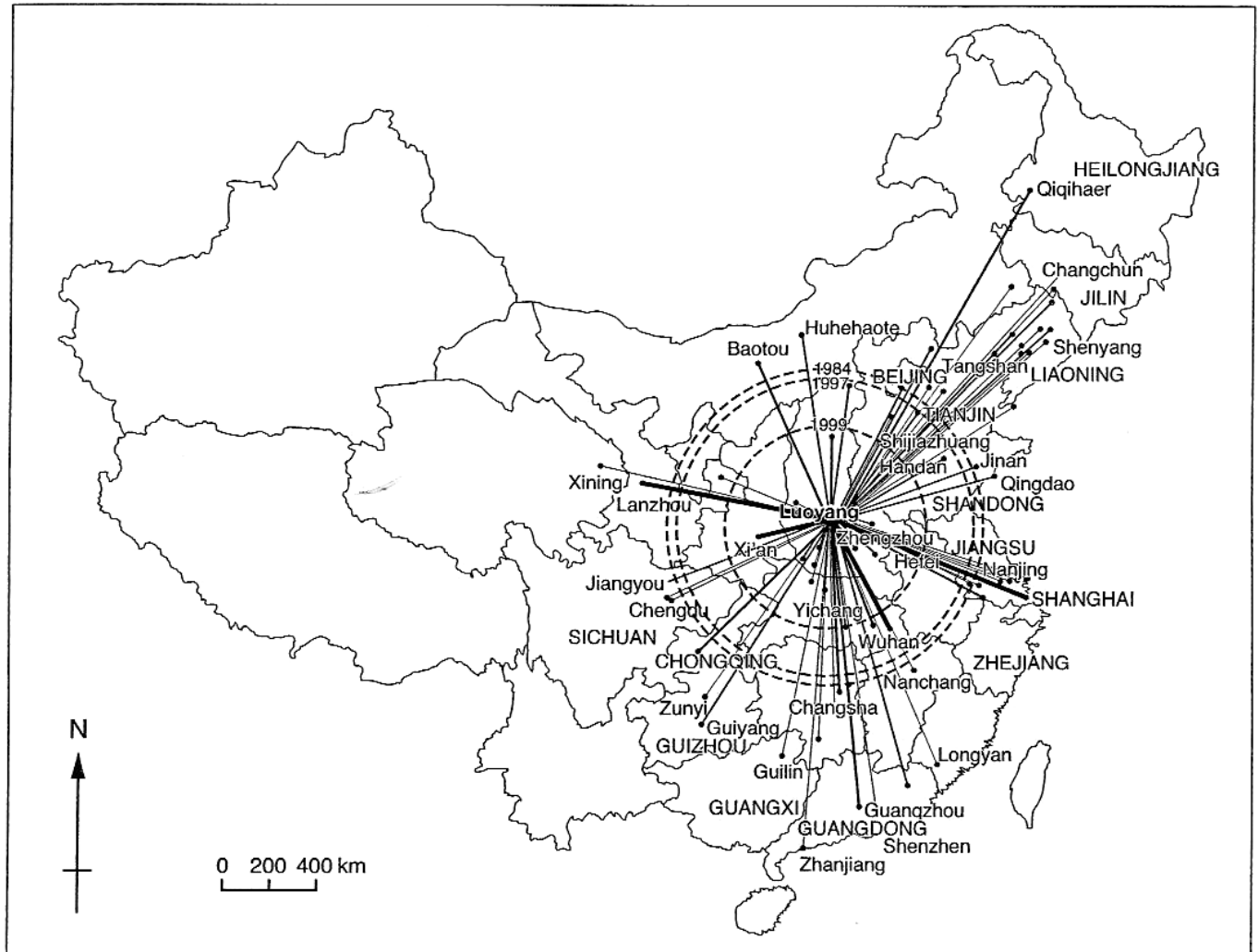

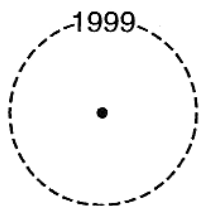

## Pioneer Generation Fund

# \$8 billion

Pioneers will receive a slew of health-care benefits for life, fully-funded by this Budget. Here are the details:

### WHO ARE THEY?



- Aged 65 and above this year
- Became a Singapore citizen before 1987
- About 450,000 people

### WHAT WILL THEY GET?

#### Help with outpatient costs

1. Additional 50 per cent off subsidised bill at specialist outpatient clinics (SOCs) and polyclinics



- This is on top of new additional subsidies for the lower and middle income
- All pioneer generation members will get total subsidies of between 75 and 85 per cent

2. Community Health Assist Scheme (Chas)



- All pioneer generation members will be placed on Chas, for subsidies at GPs and dental clinics
- Those already on Chas will have more subsidies similar to what they will have for SOCs and polyclinics

3. Disability Assistance



- Those with moderate to severe disabilities, or their nominated caregivers, will get \$1,200 a year in cash
- Must need help with at least three out of six activities of daily living: washing, dressing, feeding, toileting, mobility and transferring

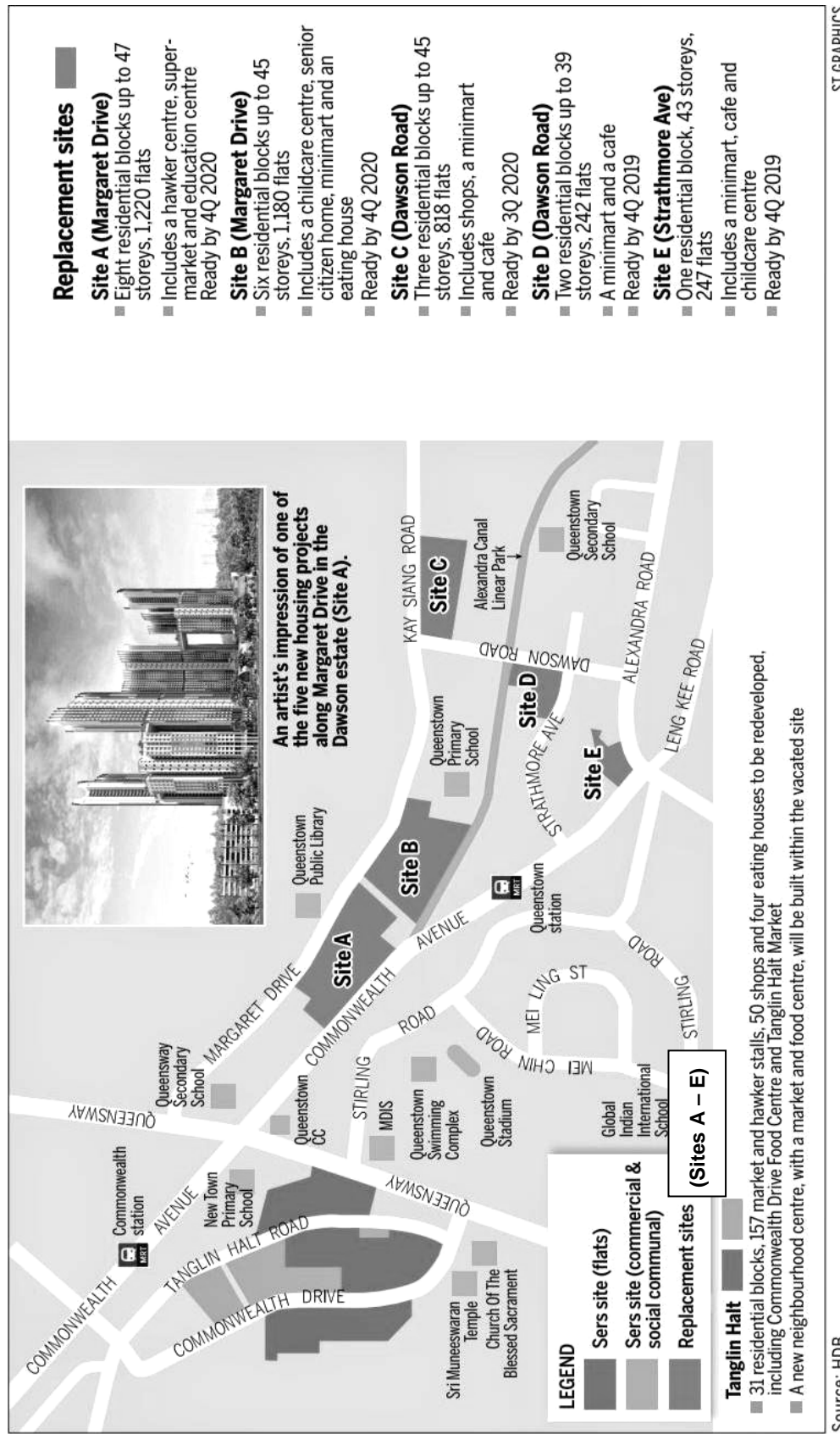

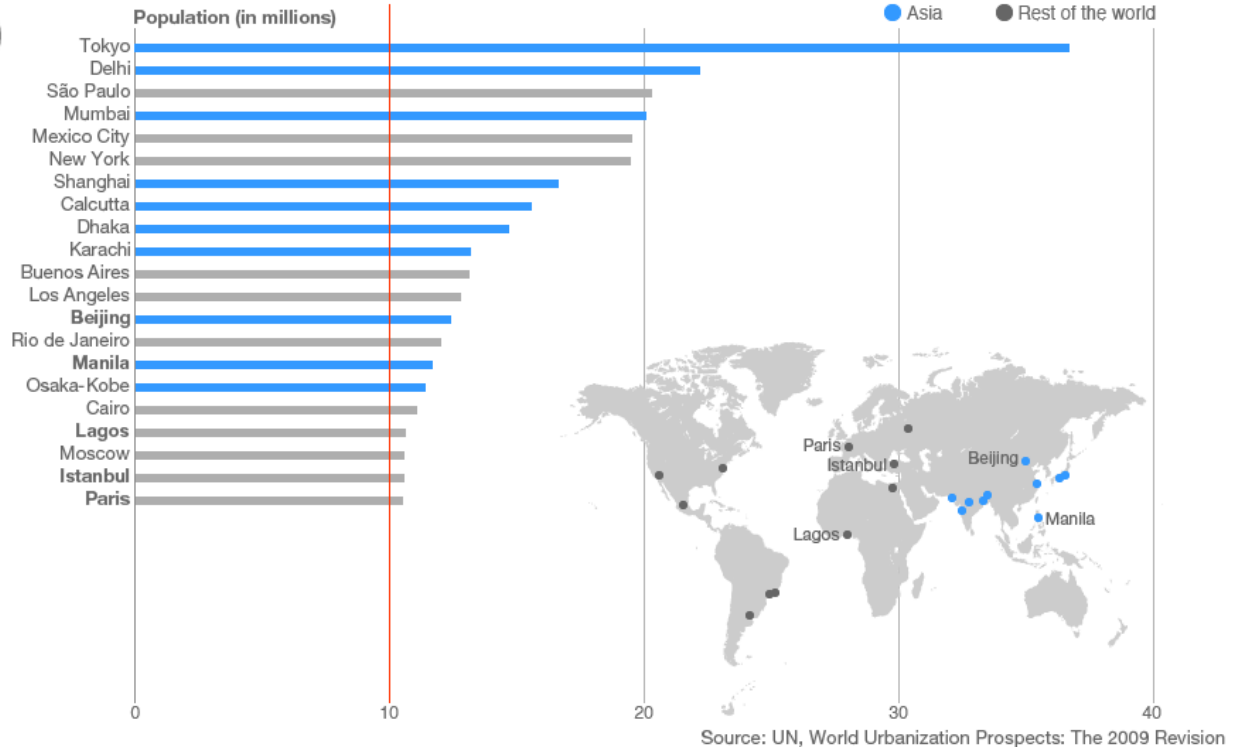

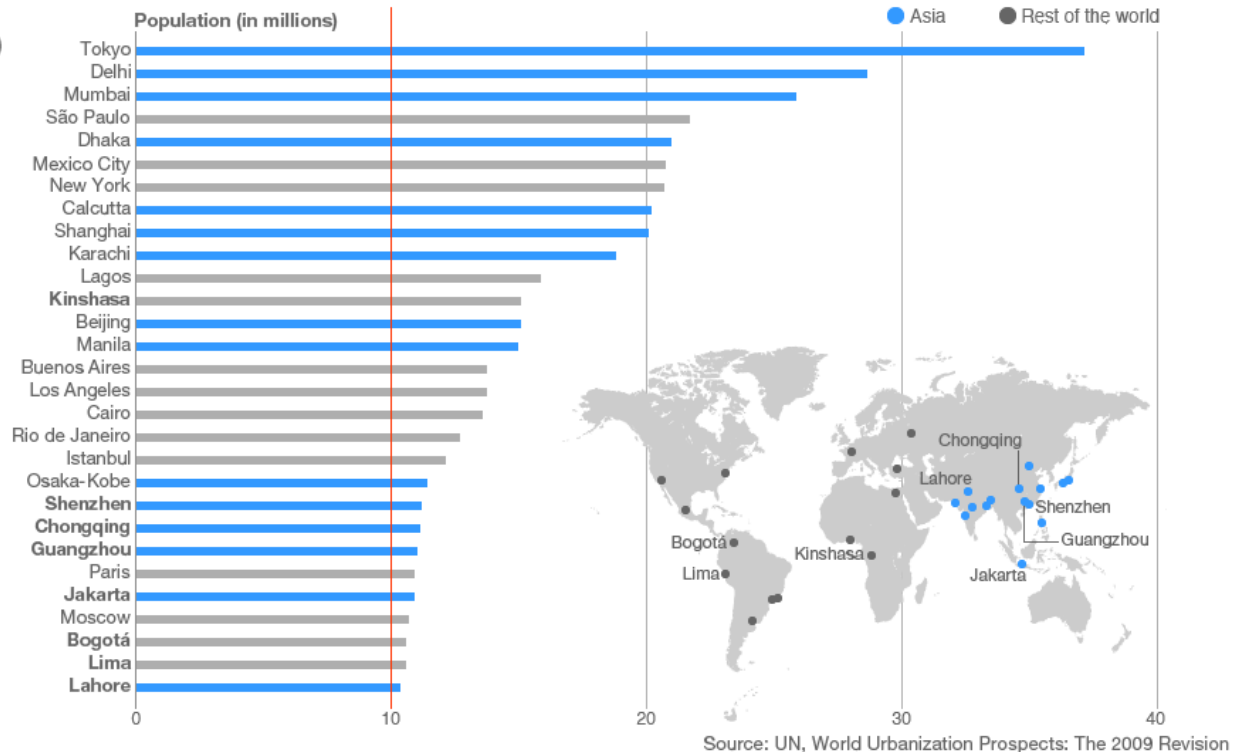
