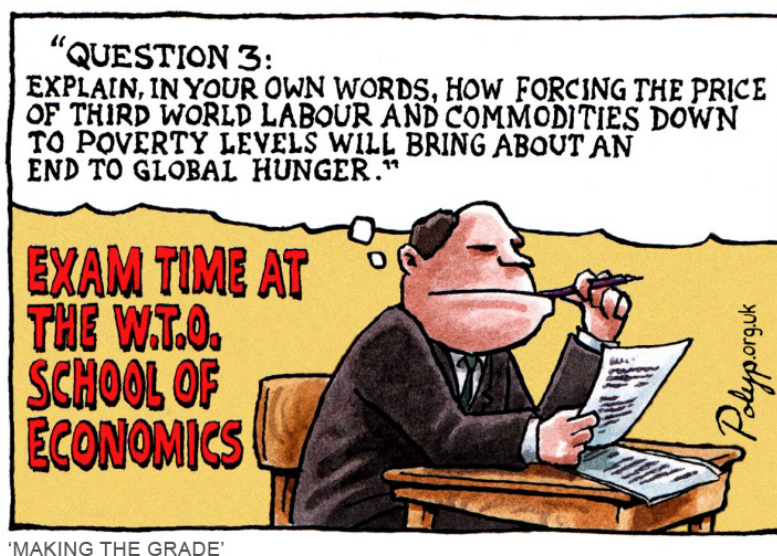
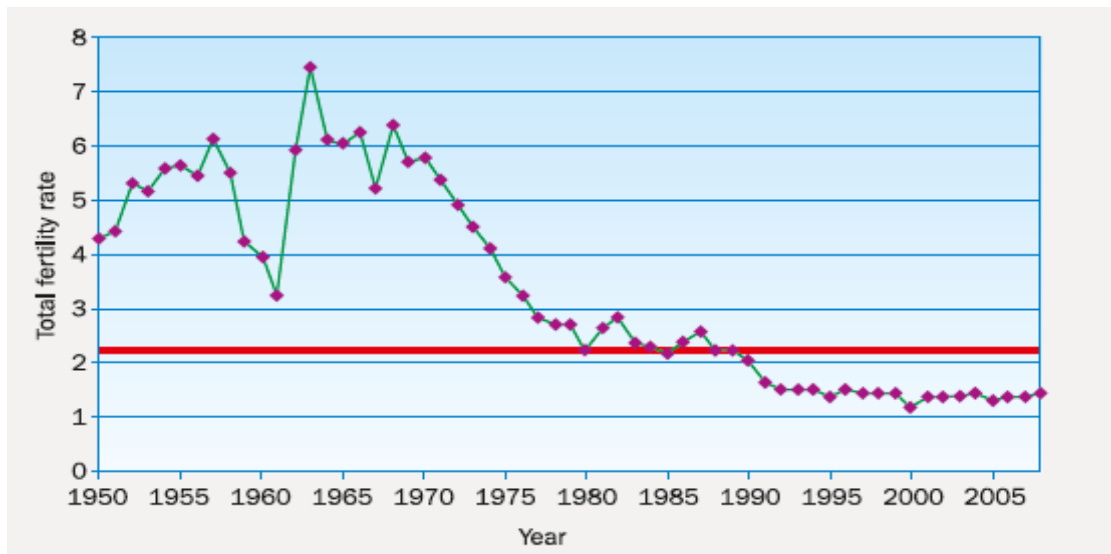

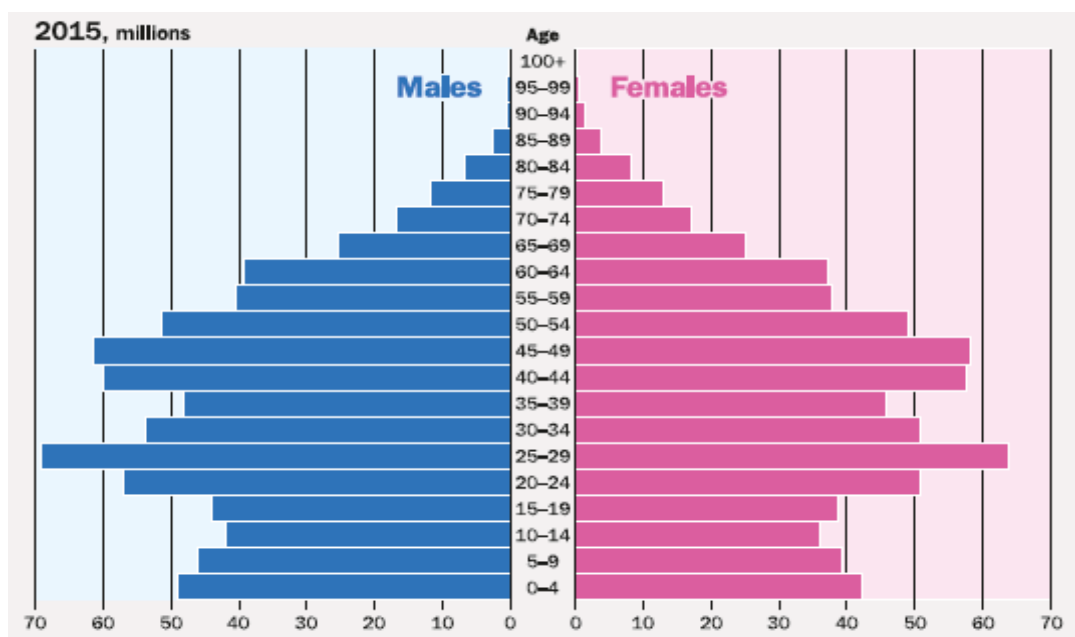

Distribution of countries with 100,000 inhabitants or more by % of their urban population; 1950, 1975, 2000 and 2030

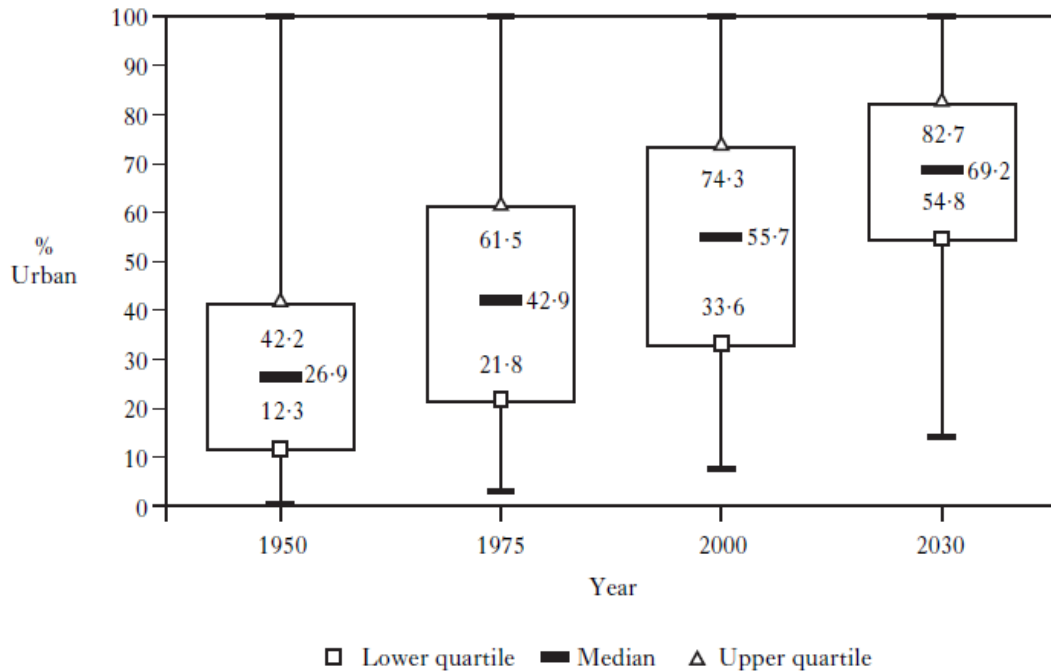

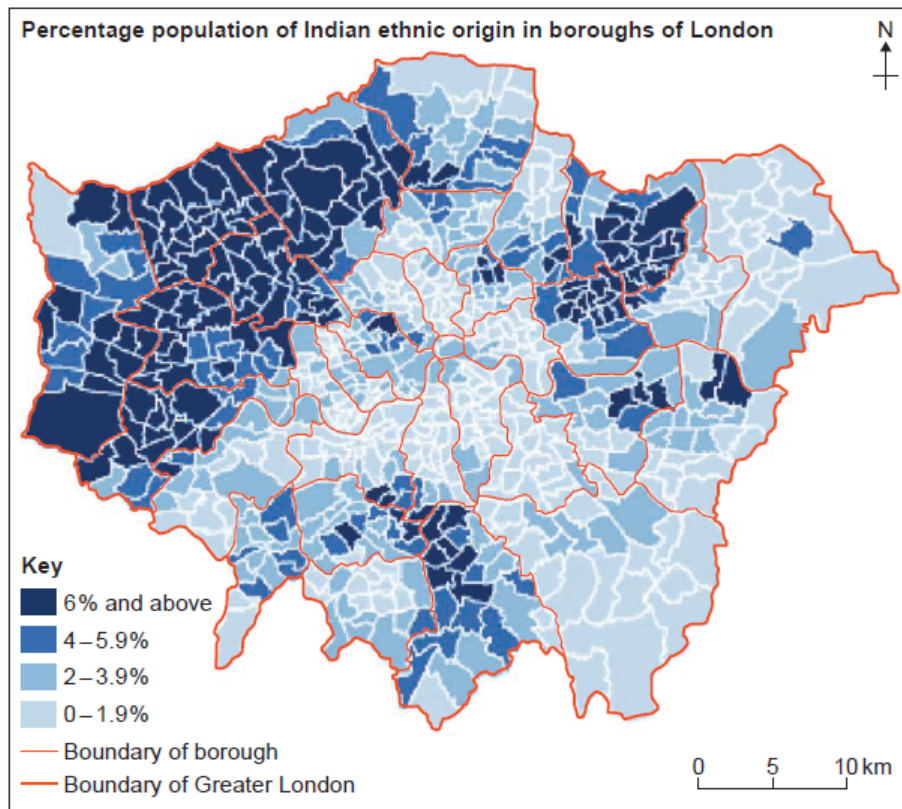

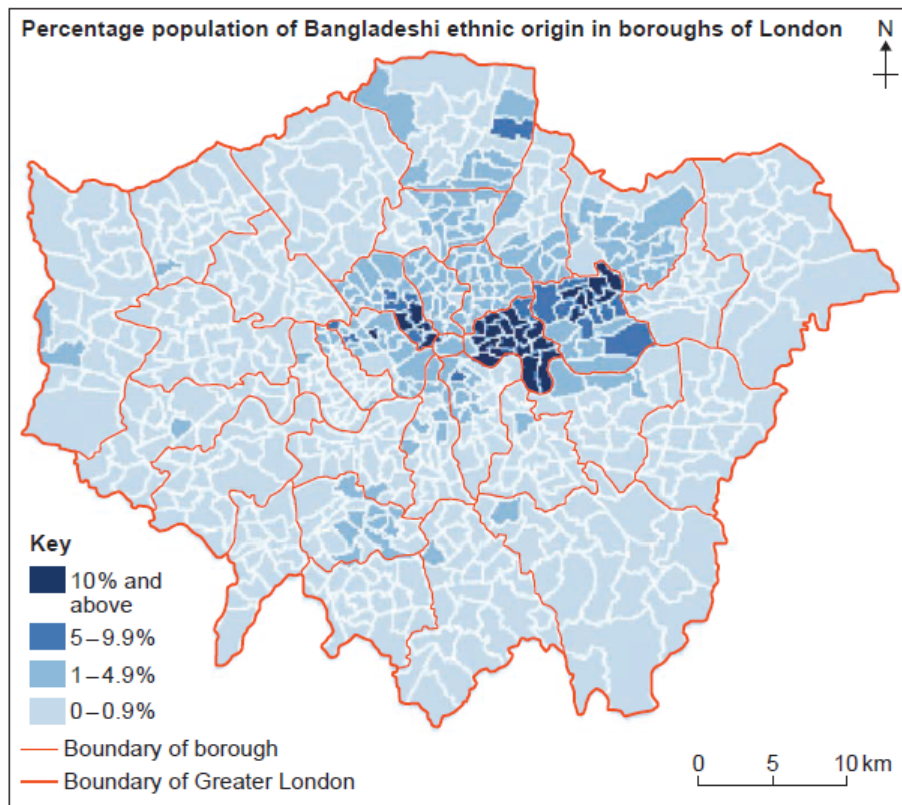

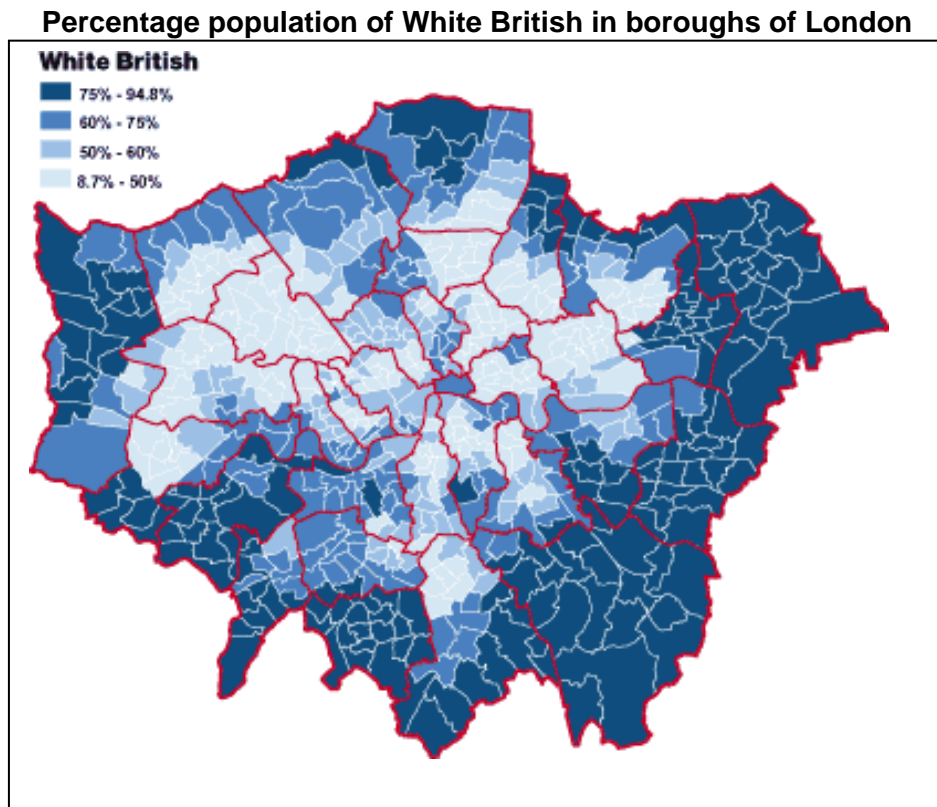
